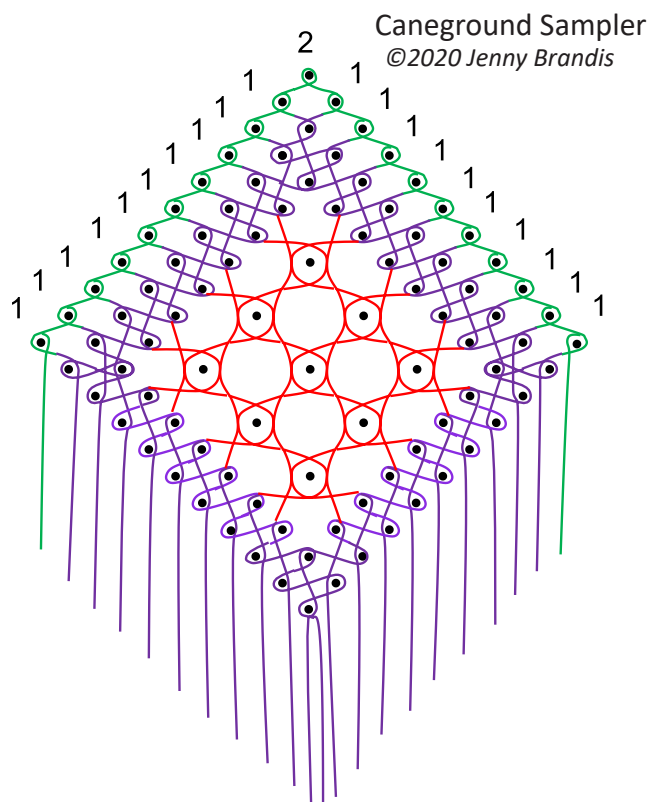
Blocking the lace

- Push down every second footside pin before removing all other pins.
- Lightly dampen a cloth and press it to the work while still on the pillow.
- Leave overnight to dry on the pillow.
- Remove the pins.

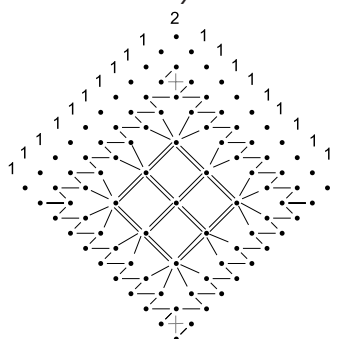

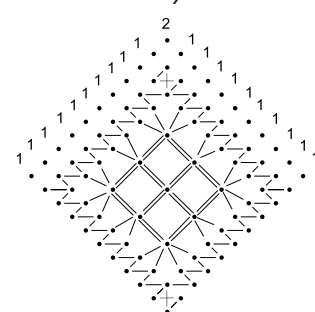

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


Methods and Stitches

- Cloth stitch (1/2) together
- Twelve ground (1/2) (1/2)
- Cloth stitch (1/2) longer
- Reverse side
- Cloth stitch (1/2) start with pin
- Cloth stitch (1/2) shorter with reverse change at center
- Ending to include leaving out pairs
