

## Pricking for Lace Christmas Tree Cards

Requires 60 pairs of bobbins wound with a variety of cotton and glitter threads.  
I used a mix of DMC Special Dentelles 80, Venus 70, Moravia Fine Glitter and Madeira Opal.

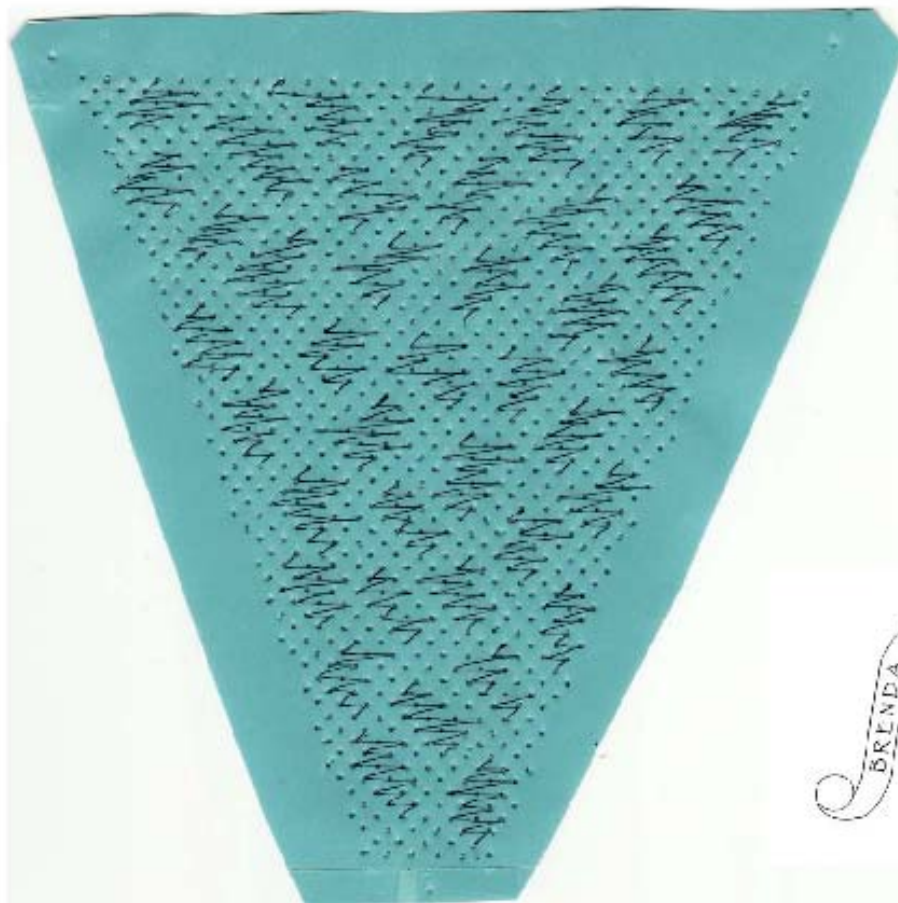
Start at the top and hang two pairs, side by side, on each pin arranging the colours randomly across the width of the pattern but ensuring that each pair stays together and work ctct.

Work conventional torchon ground (ctpct) or cloth stitch (ctc) according to the pattern.

At the edges discard pairs as necessary - just knot together and cut off.

Cut free-hand apertures in an A5 size card blank making sure that the overall size is at least 1cm smaller all round than the lace and place the lace behind. Secure with double sided tape and back with a sheet of plain (green) paper, trimmed as necessary.

Add tree tub and a few bits of peel-off to finish,
