- Needlelace

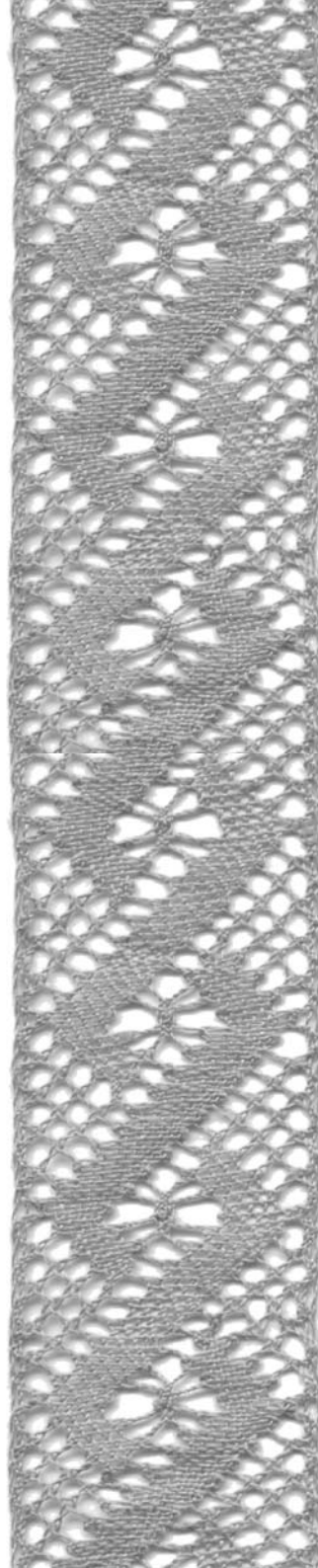
History of lace in Kununurra

1999 saw a band of 7 ladies meeting at the fabric shop to make lace. They called themselves the Ord Twisters.

Over time the membership dwindled as members moved on, and the group stopped meeting about the time that the fabric shop closed.

In 2005 interest was revived and we now have an active group of ladies who meet each week. The group changed our name to the Kununurra Lace Group in 2006 to make it easier for travelling lace makers to locate us.

Our group have members who have shown their lace at craft exhibitions and agricultural shows.
